## Let's pretend!

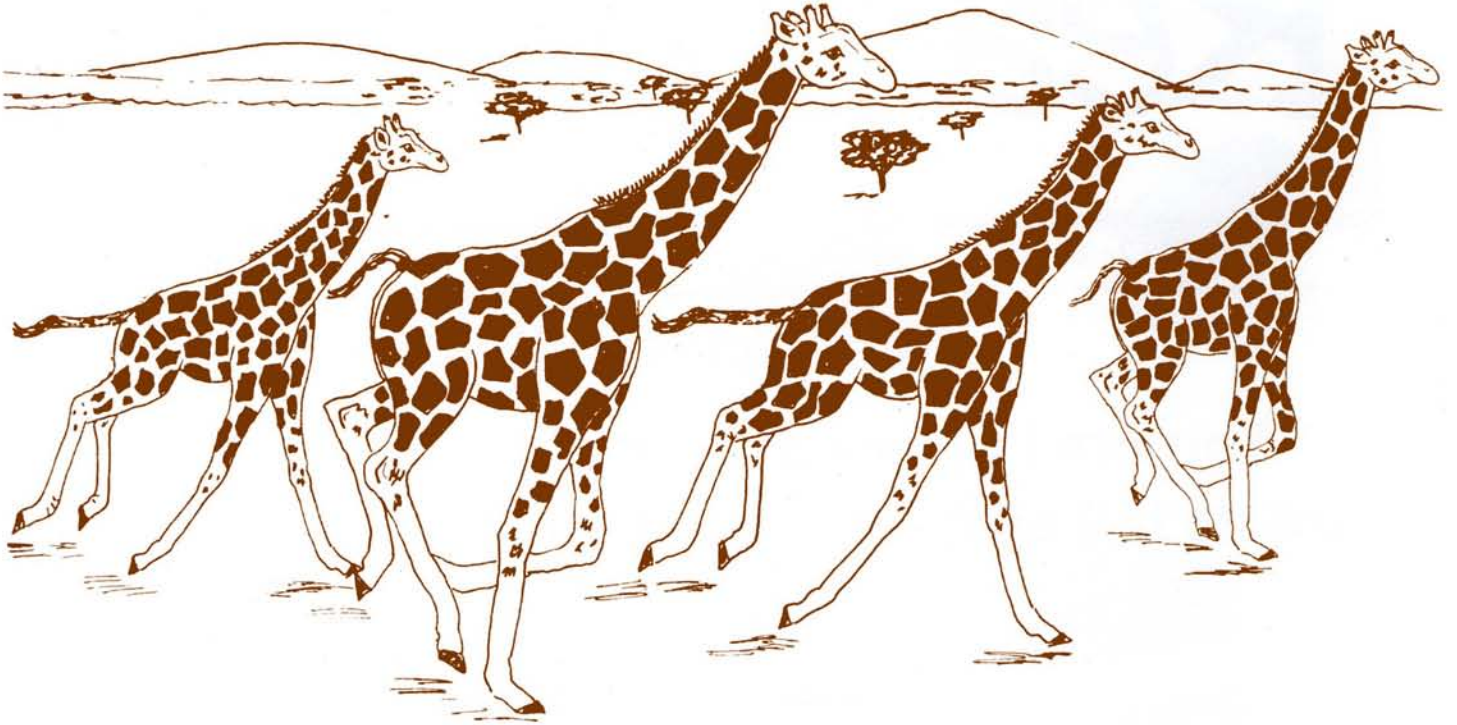
You are the tallest animal in the world.

You are as tall as a tree.

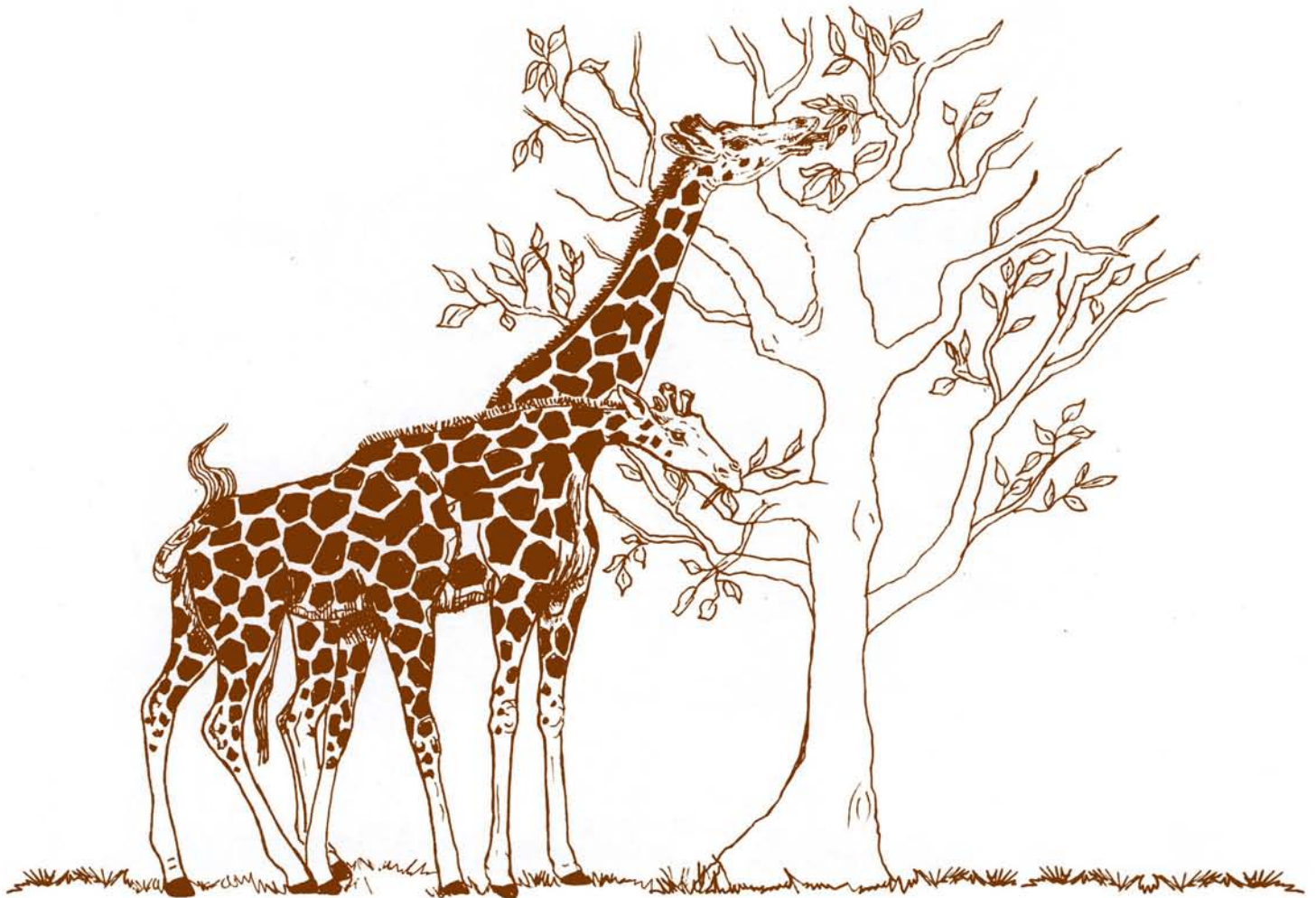
What animal are you?



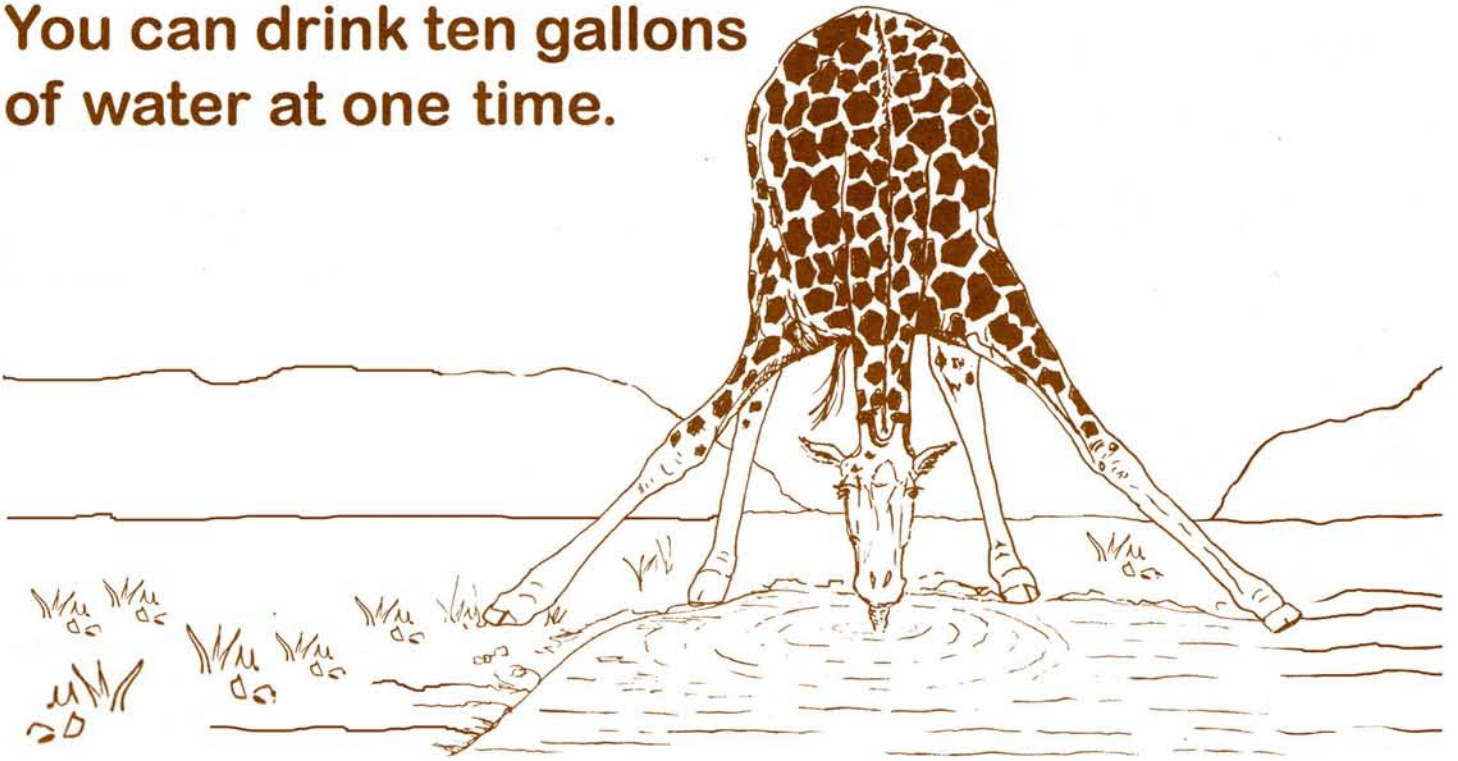
**You live in Africa. You live in a group called a herd.**



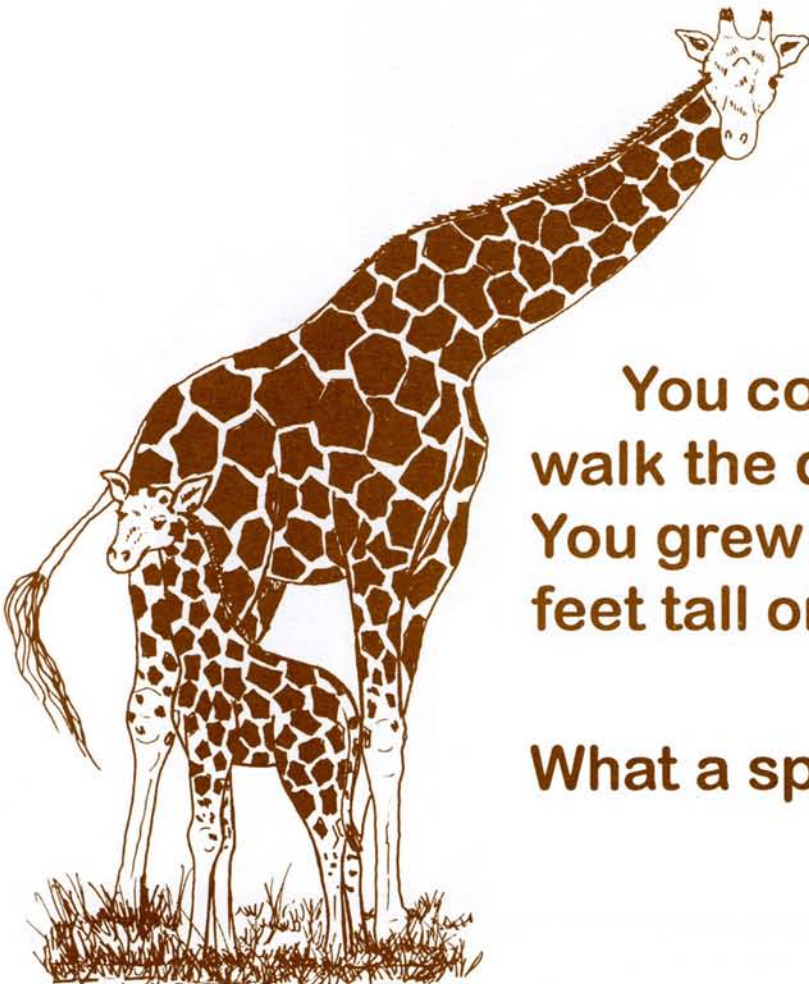
**Leaves are your favorite food.**

of water at one time.**



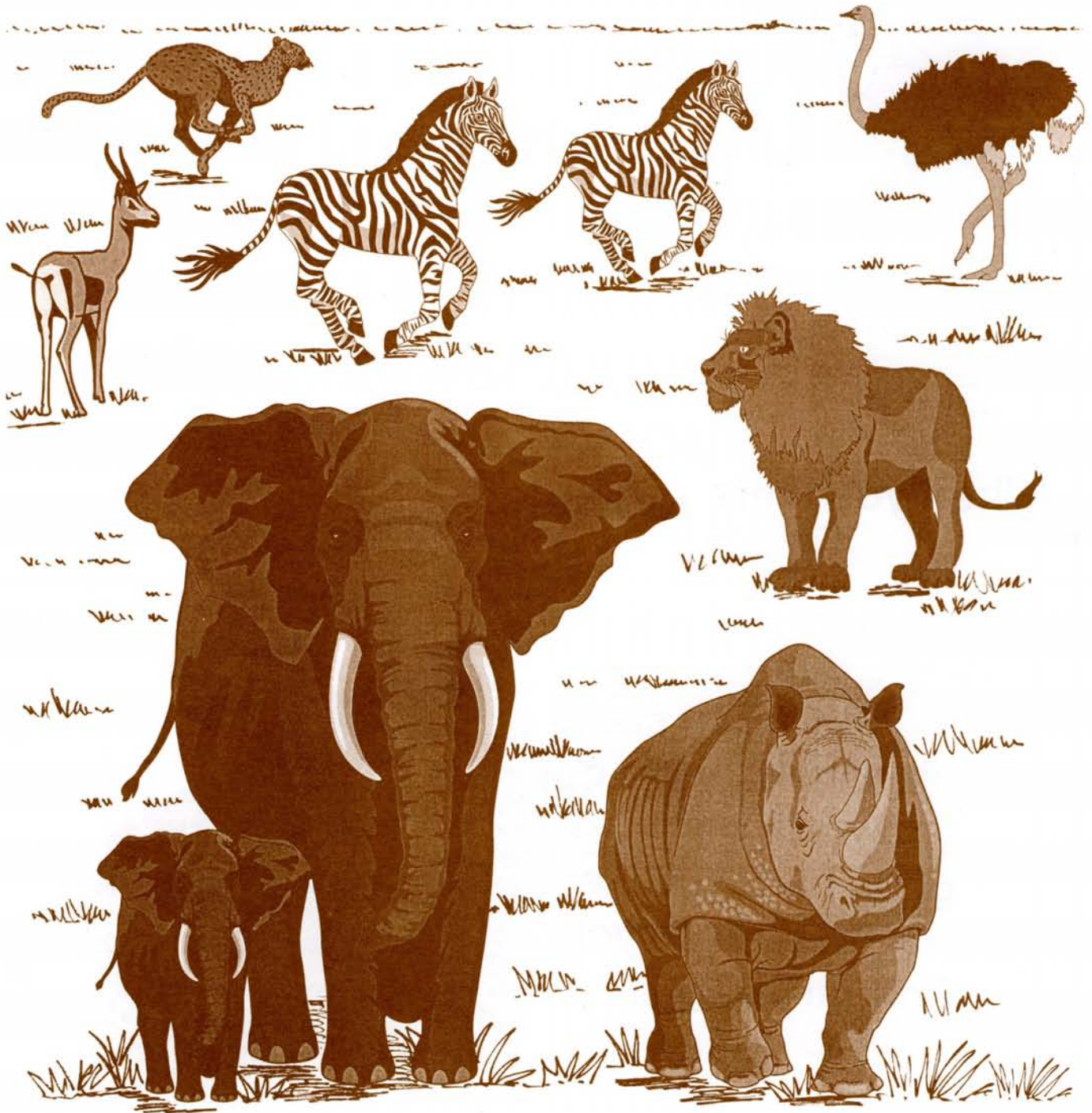
**When you were a baby...**
